As you know, your teacher has conducted an assessment with you to determine what technology you have and your availability in the event we have to move to remote instruction. This would happen if the New York State Department of Health gives an order for us to close due to a positive case of COVID-19. The Governor could also close schools if the infection rate goes beyond 5%. We must be prepared in the event either of these situations happen.

Your teachers and therapists have set up a schedule with you so that your child can receive the services indicated on their IEP's.
